## TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

- Discover Buenos Aires on a morning city tour. Visit the legendary Esquina Carlos Gardel, one of Buenos Aires's premier tango houses, for dinner and a performance. Spend time exploring the city on your own.
- Fly to Ushuaia, Argentina, the world's southernmost urban center. Tour this windswept city on the Beagle Channel. Travel to Tierra del Fuego National Park, a 155,676-acre nature preserve with Andes peaks, rivers, glacial lakes, forest, and wildlife.
- Cruise through the Beagle and Murray channels to Cape Horn National Park. Encounter sheltered Wulaia Bay for a guided walk. Take a Zodiac excursion close to the majestic Piloto and Nena glaciers. Visit Magdalena Island, home to an immense colony of Magellanic penguins and walk to the lighthouse that helps guide ships through the narrow Strait of Magellan.
- Journey to breathtaking Torres del Paine, a 700-square-mile World Biosphere Reserve. Spend time exploring this unparalleled landscape of jagged peaks, ice-blue glaciers and thunderous waterfalls. Take an excursion through the park featuring Laguna Amargo, Laguna Azul, and Cascade Rio Paine.
- Fly to Puerto Montt then enjoy an excursion to Vicente Rosales National Park. Visit conical Osorno Volcano, sprawling Petrohue Waterfalls, and the village of Ensenada on the shores of Lake Llanquihue.
- Tour Santiago including the Plaza de Armas and the renowned Pre-Columbian Museum. Dine in the homes of gracious local families. Enjoy a private tour and tasting at Viña Haras de Pirque, one of Chile's best known wineries.
- After a visit to the old port town of Valparaiso, transfer to the airport for an overnight flight back to the U.S.
